#70016 DROP SHACKLE INSTRUCTION GUIDE 2004-2014 F150 TRUCKS



- 1. With the vehicle turned off and in park, use wheel chocks to secure the front of the vehicle.
- **2.** Jack up the rear of the vehicle and place jack stands under the frame on both sides.
- **3.** Place the floor jack under the rear axle and use to relieve pressure on the factory shackles by jacking up the rear end.
- **4.** Unbolt the factory shackles.
- **5.** Install the new drop shackles, bolting them on the same way the factory shackles came off. Use the factory hardware.
- 6. The top hole will be used for a 2" drop. The bottom hole will be used for a 1" drop.
- **7.** You may need to trim the bed rail if it comes in contact with the new shackle. Relieve the small area of bed rail as needed.
- **8.** Torque all hardware to factory specs. Be sure to retighten all hardware after 1000 miles.
